Health Insurance Policy for Foreign Residents – Hebrew University Jerusalem

Dear Students,

Hebrew University issued a tender for health insurance for foreign residents in order to improve the existing policy. The tender was awarded to the Harel Insurance Company, the leading insurance company in Israel, which has specialized for decades in health insurance for foreign residents.

The new health insurance policy chosen for all students, researchers and guests from overseas is a comprehensive policy that includes broad coverage.

The following are the health insurance premiums:

NIS 8.20/day per insured person, linked to the index

NIS 9.75/day per insured person, linked to the index, for students of the Faculty of Agriculture in Rehovot, that get the medical service from Clalit Health Services

To purchase the insurance policy, please complete and sign the attached health insurance application.

The following are instructions for completing the application:

- Be sure to complete all fields.
- List the insurance dates as follows: from the date of the insurance application, but not before the date of signature on the Declaration of Health Condition, until the final date of the academic year – 30 September 2018.
- Make sure to fill in your student number.

Payment of the insurance policy:

For your information, upon establishment of the policy, the cost will be added to your student account and will become part of your total charges.

You can arrange payment for the insurance policy by credit card or by electronic payment yourself, on the Personal Information site.

The insurance policy will be sent to you by email and the insurance card will be sent to you to the Faculty.
